Dear BGE Customer:

In August 2020, you may have received a letter regarding a virtual community meeting for the replacement of several wood poles with steel poles along the existing 4-mile transmission line corridor, stretching from the Perryman substation to the Harford substation in Harford County, Maryland. This work is part of BGE's ongoing investment in the safety and reliability of the energy systems serving you.

BGE's contractors, Power Grid, will begin construction for this project in late November 2020 and will continue to the end of 2021. As part of this work, you may see crews performing routine maintenance on stone access roads within and adjacent to BGE easements. Additionally, you may see helicopters in the area dropping off materials required for construction. Work hours are expected to be Monday through Saturday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Construction activity is weather dependent so certain conditions (wind, rain, thunderstorms, etc.) may impact the ability to work. In the event of weather-related interruptions during the work week, construction may extend into Sunday if needed.

As the COVID-19 pandemic continues to evolve and impact our community, BGE wants to reaffirm with you our commitment to the safety and well-being of our customers, employees, and contractors. Safety is our top priority. We have implemented important procedures to prioritize the health of our community. All BGE employees and contractors have been instructed to follow health and safety best practices consistent with CDC guidelines including, but not limited to, practicing safe social distancing, and wearing personal protective equipment (PPE).
